This term, we'll dive into the world of Space, Depth, and Illusion — a journey through how artists build perspective, suggest atmosphere, and bend visual logic to tell stories. From classical cityscapes to dreamlike distortions, you'll explore a wide range of techniques and media to master the art of spatial composition.

Duration: 9 Sessions Medium: Watercolor, Oil, Charcoal, Soft Pastel, Ink, Mixed Media

🜔 Lesson 1: Skeleton of Space – Architectural Perspective

Medium: Ink liner + watercolor wash Theme: "Deserted City: Structure as Drama" Artist Reference: Giovanni Battista Piranesi (dramatic architecture) Skills Focus: 2-point linear perspective (urban structures, empty streets)

Lesson 2: Light and Geometry – Shadows in Space

Medium: Charcoal + white chalk on tinted paper Theme: "Single Object in Void" Artist Reference: Giorgio de Chirico (metaphysical stillness) Skills Focus: Building shadows in correct perspective, geometric light

Lesson 3-5: Atmospheric Perspective – The Art of Distance

Medium: Oil painting on canvas, glazing and layering Theme: "The Vanishing Horizon" Artist Reference: J.M.W. Turner (atmosphere and emotion) Skills Focus: Fading contrast and color depth in multi-layered landscapes

Lesson 6-7: Object Scale – Foreground, Middleground, Background

Medium: Soft pastel Artist Reference: Caspar David Friedrich (figures in space) Skills Focus: Composition with depth, storytelling through scale



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Lesson 8–9: Deformed Space – Perspective as Emotion

Medium: Charcoal, collage, textured surfaces Theme: "The City in a Dream" Artist Reference: M.C. Escher (distorted logic of space) Skills Focus: Tilted horizons, extreme angles, altered vanishing points

Possible other topics

Reverse and Iconic Perspective

Medium: Ink, watercolor, gold paint Theme: "Quiet Inner World" Artist Reference: Andrei Rublev or Ukiyo-e prints (nonlinear space) Skills Focus: Medieval and non-Western space logic (no vanishing point)

Reflections and Doubled Depth

Medium: Watercolor + pencil or mixed media Theme: "Reversed Reality" Artist Reference: Johannes Vermeer (interior reflections) Skills Focus: Perspective in water, mirrors, glass — reflected distance

Macro/Micro Worlds: Shifting Scale

Medium: Mixed: oil, pastel, texture paste Theme: "A Universe Under a Leaf" Artist Reference: Yayoi Kusama (infinity and repetition) Skills Focus: From wide view to microscopic detail (perspective through contrast)
